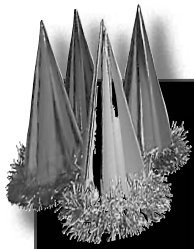
Children MUST meet the age requirement before classes begin to qualify. Students not meeting the age requirement will be withdrawn from class.
